Proteolysis targeting chimeras (PROTACs) offer a novel alternative to traditional small molecules. They inhibit proteins by binding to their functional regions and by recruiting E3 ligases to target the protein for degradation through the cells natural ubiquitin/proteasome pathway. This event will focus on the recent developments in the field, provide an opportunity to learn about the types of protein complexes that are being considered as PROTAC targets and provide an introduction to those new to the field who are looking to start engaging with PROTACs within their own research.
