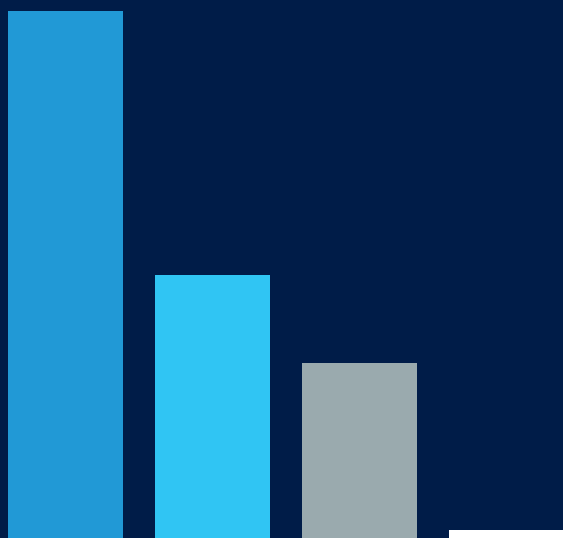

54% First Time Attendees at an ELRIG Event

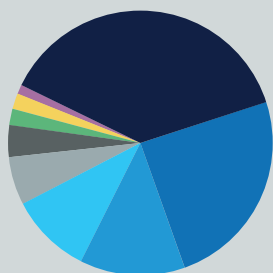

KEY EVENTS

ELRIG organises up to 6 scientific conferences and 6 networking meetings per year, that will have anywhere between 40 to 1500 attendees. Meetings may be an afternoon only to 2 days in length and have a very narrow focus or contain a broad range of topics, applicable to many research areas within the drug discovery community. Our most well known annual events are:

DISCOVERY TECHNOLOGIES which explores new technologies that may be used to prosecute drug discovery campaigns against new and novel targets.

DRUG DISCOVERY is Europe's largest event for all aspects of drug discovery and the place that life sciences industry professionals meet to learn, share, connect, innovate and collaborate network.

RESEARCH AND INNOVATION which provides a forum where emerging opportunities in drug discovery research, often as they first arise in the academic arena, may be presented and discussed.

All ELRIG events are free of charge to attend, for all members of the community.
